These rules largely mimic FERPA and consequently apply to charter schools. Additionally, a charter school meets the definition of "educational agency" in OAR 581-021-0220(5)). While these related requirements apply to charter schools, this section does not make them part of Division 22. (2) contains nothing that would make it apply to a charter school. (4) applies to ESDs.

Furthermore, this provision requires the department to collect information from school districts regarding "public school[s] within the district." Generally, charter schools are not considered schools within the district. Charters are required to meet PE requirements in ORS 329.496 by ORS 338.115(1)(k).

Inasmuch as charter schools are obligated to follow laws related to this specific conduct, this provision would apply. For example, OAR 581-022-2370(4) provides specific requirements for complaints of discrimination in violation of ORS 659.850. Charter schools are subject to ORS 659.850, so this provision would apply to charter schools. However, the generic complaint procedure requirements found in OAR 581-022-2370(1) and (2) would not apply to charter schools.
